AGREED JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGEMENT

Comes now for hearing on this 6th day of December, 2001, the petition of the State of Oklahoma ex rel. W.A. Drew Edmondson, Attorney General, against Satellites Direct, Inc., hereafter "Defendant". Having been advised that the parties have reached an agreement settling the Plaintiff's claims in this matter, this Court hereby finds as follows:

1. That this action is brought in the public interest by W.A. Drew Edmondson, the duly elected Attorney General for the State of Oklahoma to prohibit Defendant from using an automatic dial announcing device in violation of 15 O.S. § 755.1 of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act, and operating as an unregistered commercial telephone seller in violation of 15 O.S. § 775A.3.

2. That standing of the Attorney General to commence this action is conferred by 15

O.S. § 756.1.

3. That Defendant, Satellites Direct, Inc. (hereinafter “Defendant”), is an Oklahoma corporation with its principal place of business in Norman, Oklahoma. Defendant was engaged in the sale and installation of satellite television systems.

4. That Defendant has been duly served with the Petition.

5. Plaintiff appears by and through its attorneys, W.A. Drew Edmondson, Attorney General, and Thomas A. Bates, Assistant Attorney General, 4545 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, 73105.

6. Defendant appears by and through its President, Mike Higgins.

7. That this Court is the proper venue for this action.

8. Defendant admits that in the course of its business, through its agents and representatives, it has operated as a “commercial telephone seller” as defined in 15 O.S. §775A.2. Defendant further admits that it has operated as a commercial telephone seller without registering with the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Office as required by 15 O.S. §775A.3.

9. Defendant’s operation as a commercial telephone seller without registering with the Oklahoma Attorney General’s Office is in violation of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act and is punishable by a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000.00 per violation as set forth by 15 O.S. §761.1(C).

10. Defendant further admits that in the course of its business it has operated an automatic dial announcing device in violation of 15 O.S. §755.1.

11. Defendant's operation of an automatic dial announcing device is in violation of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act and is punishable by a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000.00 per violation as set forth by 15 O.S. §761.1(C).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT

Defendant shall cease and is hereby enjoined from acting as a "commercial telephone seller" as defined in 15 O.S. §775A.2. until such time as Defendant has complied 15 O.S. §775A.3. by registering with the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office.

Defendant shall cease and is hereby enjoined from operating an automatic dial announcing device unless such operation complies strictly with the provision of 15 O.S. §755.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT

Defendant shall pay a stipulated Civil Penalty of \$20,000.00 to the Oklahoma Attorney General's Office.






